Polish offshore wind is growing, but it is new area of business in Poland. New challenges will require solid legal support built on deep experience in dispute avoidance, claim management, contrac-tual litigation. We are a leading Polish law firm specialising in contractual ongoing advice, regulatory issues and legal representation regarding large construction and infrastructure projects. We boast one of the largest teams in Poland providing legal support in infrastructure matters. We strictly cooperate also with our real estate team.

We are proud to be among top Polish law firms advising general contractors, subcontractors, investors, performing complex projects in the area of power facilities, hydrotechnical projects, engineering, renewables, buildings, public facilities, roads, sports facilities, and industrial facilities.

We have experience in supporting parties in financing of engineering projects in Poland. We have been also involved in reviewing periodic reports prepared by contractors for financing institutions.

We regularly advise 10 out of 15 largest Polish construction companies (according to Deloitte's report), in matters related to their business - critical claims. The Polish offshore market is just developing, but we see from the first contracts that it will be carried out in large part with the major contractors already present in Poland.

We provide ongoing legal advice on most >850 million EUR engineering projects in Poland.

Our energy experts advice on executing, amending and performing crucial agreements in the energy sector, including grid connection agreements, EPC contracts, BoP agreements, equipment supply agreements, O&M agreements, transmission and distribution agreements, and power purchase agreements (PPA, cPPA). They worked for financial institutions financing renewables projects.

Currently, we are handling more than 180 court and arbitration proceedings worth more than PLN 3,2 billion. Some of the cases that we work on involve claims worth PLN 200-500 million. In many of the disputes that we have handled, we have secured settlements beneficial to our clients.

JDP advised a general contractor in a settled dispute regarding a design and construction of a power unit with a steam boiler for pulverised fuel in a "turnkey" formula concerning an increase in remuneration due to an extraordinary increase in prices after 2014 (value in dispute: over PLN 252 million).

Final and binding judgment by the Appellate Court in Warsaw that, in late 2017, for the first time found that an increase in asphalt prices was extraordinary and unforeseeable, and the loss suffered by the contractor qualified as a "serious loss".

We have been advising on the construction of the Varso building complex in Warsaw. An important part of the complex is Varso Tower, which is currently the tallest building in the European Union. JDP has been advising the investor, which at the same time acts as the general contractor, on contract-related matters that are crucial for the timely completion of the project. The construction of the Varso complex is challenging from the legal point of view due to, among other things, the project location, use of unique materials and technologies, and the necessity to coordinate several subcontractors from various branches.

Thanks to the legal inputs from our infrastructure, M&A, real estate and tax teams, we can advise on all aspects of complex and multifaceted projects.



- obtaining real estate title and required administrative permits (such as environmental decisions, zoning decisions, building permits) for energy infrastructure projects, in particular RES and energy storage projects;
- legal and tax due diligence for the purpose of acquiring, or financing the acquisition or implementation of RES projects;

- drafting and advising on concluding and performing agreements for the construction and use of renewable energy sources, including, EPC, BoP, and equipment supply and O&M contracts:
- advising on support systems, including auction procedures on the RES market;
- advising on regulatory issues including concessions, tariffs, and reporting and disclosure obligations of energy companies;
- providing advice and representation in a case before the President of the Polish Energy Regulatory Office and the Court of Competition and Consumer Protection;

- advising on price limiting mechanisms for energy, heat and gas prices, including price caps, compensation for price caps, and Price Difference Payment Fund write-offs.






